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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADVISORY BOARDS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 163D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:

4           "§163D-    Advisory board. (a) There is established an  
5 advisory board to the corporation. The advisory board shall  
6 focus on workforce development for the agricultural industry.

7           (b) The board shall consist of the following members:

8           (1) The director of labor and industrial relations, or the  
9           director's designee;

10          (2) The superintendent of education, or the  
11          superintendent's designee;

12          (3) The vice president of community colleges for the  
13          university of Hawaii, or the vice president's  
14          designee;

15          (4) A representative of the Hawaii Farm Bureau, or their  
16          designee, who shall be invited by the governor to  
17          participate; and



1       (5) Three individuals with appropriate experience, who  
 2       shall be appointed by the governor, and whose terms  
 3       shall end at the end of each gubernatorial term;  
 4       provided that the governor may reappoint any member  
 5       serving pursuant to this paragraph; provided further  
 6       that nongovernmental members shall be invited by the  
 7       governor to participate.

8       (c) The advisory board shall meet as often as practicable,  
 9       but not less than once per \_\_\_\_\_.

10       (d) The appointed members of the advisory board shall  
 11       serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses,  
 12       including travel expenses, necessary for the performance of  
 13       their duties."

14       SECTION 2. Chapter 206M, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
 15       amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately  
 16       designated and to read as follows:

17       "§206M-    Advisory board. (a) There is established an  
 18       advisory board to the development corporation. The advisory  
 19       board shall focus on workforce development for the technology  
 20       industry.

21       (b) The board shall consist of the following members:



1       (1) The director of labor and industrial relations, or the  
2            director's designee;

3       (2) The superintendent of education, or the  
4            superintendent's designee;

5       (3) The vice president of community colleges for the  
6            university of Hawaii, or the vice president's  
7            designee;

8       (4) A representative of the Hawaii Farm Bureau, or the  
9            representative's designee, to be invited by the  
10           governor to participate; and

11       (5) Three individuals with appropriate experience, who  
12            shall be appointed by the governor, and whose terms  
13            shall end at the end of each gubernatorial term;  
14            provided that the governor may reappoint any member  
15            serving pursuant to this paragraph; provided further  
16            that nongovernmental members shall be invited by the  
17            governor to participate.

18       (c) The advisory board shall meet as often as practicable,

3 SECTION 3. Chapter 227D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
4 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
5 and to read as follows:

6 "§227D- Advisory board. (a) There is established an  
7 advisory board to the authority. The advisory board shall  
8 focus on workforce development for the natural energy industry.

9 (b) The board shall consist of the following members:

10 (1) The director of labor and industrial relations, or the  
11 director's designee;

12 (2) The superintendent of education, or the  
13 superintendent's designee;

14 (3) The vice president of community colleges for the  
15 university of Hawaii, or the vice president's  
16 designee;

17 (4) A representative of the Hawaii Farm Bureau, or the  
18 representative's designee, to be invited by the  
19 governor to participate; and

20 (5) Three individuals with appropriate experience, who  
21 shall be appointed by the governor, and whose terms



1           shall end at the end of each gubernatorial term;  
2           provided that the governor may reappoint any member  
3           serving pursuant to this paragraph; provided further  
4           that nongovernmental members shall be invited by the  
5           governor to participate.

6           (c) The advisory board shall meet as often as practicable,  
7           but not less than once per \_\_\_\_\_.

8           (d) The appointed members of the advisory board shall  
9           serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses,  
10          including travel expenses, necessary for the performance of  
11          their duties."

12           SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

13           SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2060.
