RELATING TO LEGAL REPRESENTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 802-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) Any indigent person who is:
- 4 (1) Arrested for, charged with, or convicted of an offense
- 5 or offenses punishable by confinement in jail or
- 6 prison or for which the person may be or is subject to
- 7 the provisions of chapter 571;
- 8 (2) Threatened by confinement, against the indigent
- 9 person's will, in any psychiatric or other mental
- institution or facility;
- 11 [(3) The subject of a petition for assisted community
- 12 treatment under chapter 334;] or
- 13 $\left[\frac{4}{3}\right]$ The subject of a petition for involuntary medical
- 14 treatment under chapter 353,
- 15 shall be entitled to be represented by a public defender. If,
- 16 however, conflicting interests exist, or if the public defender



- 1 for any other reason is unable to act, or if the interests of
- 2 justice require, the court may appoint other counsel."
- 3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
