A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE, ITS OFFICERS, OR ITS EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I
2	SECTION 1. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
3	the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
4	37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
5	that the general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2023-
6	2024 has already been exceeded by \$1,005,342,735 or 9.4 per
7	cent. The appropriations contained in this Act will cause the
8	state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2023-2024
9	to be further exceeded by or per cent. This
10	declaration takes into account the additional general fund
11	appropriation authorized for fiscal year 2023-2024 in this Act
12	only. The reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure
13	ceiling are that:
14	(1) The appropriations made in this Act are necessary to
15	serve the public interest; and
16	(2) The appropriations made in this Act meet the needs

3	of the attorney general before payment of any claim may be made.
4	SECTION 5. Notwithstanding the sums hereinabove stated as
5	interest upon judgments against the State, payment of interest
6	shall be limited to the period from the date of the judgment, if
7	applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this Act,
8	as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for those
9	cases to which the statute applies.
10	SECTION 6. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
11	appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on
12	June 30, 2025, shall lapse.
13	SECTION 7. If any provision of this Act, or the
14	application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held
15	invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
16	applications of the Act that can be given effect without the
17	invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
18	of this Act are severable.
19	SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

PURPOSE: To provide for the authorization and payment

> of claims against the State for refunds of taxes, for judgments and settlements, and for other miscellaneous payments as provided by chapters 37, 661, and 662, Hawaii Revised

Statutes.

Authorize and appropriate funds for the MEANS:

payment of such claims.

This bill serves as the vehicle by which JUSTIFICATION:

claims against the State are transmitted to the Legislature for its consideration. Legislature will be asked to authorize and

fund the payment of such claims by an

appropriation of general and special funds. Timely passage of this bill will serve to minimize interest on those amounts for which

interest is accruing.

Impact on the public: There would be no direct impact on the public other than the

persons whose claims are being paid.

Impact on the department and other agencies: Claims eligible for payment from a special fund will generally be charged to that special fund rather than the general fund.

Certain claims will be paid from a

department's appropriation as reflected in

the budget bill. In such case, that

department will be responsible for finding the moneys in its budget to pay for the judgments and settlements rendered against

it.
