A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE II OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
- 2 amendment to article II of the Constitution of the State of
- 3 Hawaii to allow the State to enact laws establishing limitations
- 4 on moneys expended by any independent expenditure committee to
- 5 influence the outcome of a state election.
- 6 SECTION 2. Article II of the Constitution of the State of
- 7 Hawaii is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately
- 8 designated and to read as follows:
- 9 "INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE COMMITTEES, EXPENDITURE LIMITS
- 10 **Section** . Limitations on moneys expended by any
- 11 independent expenditure committee to influence the outcome of a
- 12 state election shall be provided by law."
- 13 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
- 14 be as follows:
- 15 "Shall the Hawaii State Constitution be amended to allow
- the Legislature to enact laws establishing limitations on
