A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE TIRES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 342I, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§342I- Tire inventory database. (a) For each motor
5 vehicle tire sold by a tire retailer, the tire retailer shall
6 collect and submit to the department of health the following
7 information:

8 (1) The purchaser's name;

9 (2) The model and serial number of each motor vehicle tire
10 sold; and

11 (3) The date of sale.

12 (b) The department of health shall establish and maintain
13 a database containing the information reported pursuant to
14 subsection (a).

15 (c) Any tire retailer violating the requirements of
16 subsection (a) shall be fined for each offense."

1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
3 begun before its effective date.

4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
