A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE CAPITOL TOURS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 21G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§21G- State capitol tours program. There shall be
5 established within the office of the lieutenant governor a state
6 capitol tours program to be administered and facilitated by the
7 office, and which shall include in-person and self-guided
8 walking tours as well as virtual tours of the Hawaii state
9 capitol building; provided that:

10 (1) Paper brochures and information about the virtual tour
11 website shall also be made available to the public
12 whether on an in-person guided tours or a self-guided
13 walking tour; and

14 (2) Administration of virtual tours of the capitol shall
15 include maintenance and regular updating of a virtual
16 tour website."




1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
5 year 2024-2025 for the administration and facilitation of a
6 state capitol tour program pursuant to this Act.

7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the office of
8 the lieutenant governor for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
