## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING EACH OF THE COUNTY COUNCILS TO ADOPT SUPPLEMENTAL RULES PURSUANT TO SECTION 514B-6, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES, TO ENSURE CONFORMANCE OF CONDOMINIUM PROPERTY REGIMES TO THE PURPOSES AND PROVISIONS OF COUNTY ZONING AND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCES AND CHAPTER 205, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES, INCLUDING SECTION 205-4.6, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES, WHERE APPLICABLE.

WHEREAS, there has been growing interest in developing 1 agricultural lands in the Kunia area; and 2 3 WHEREAS, while this provides land developers with a process 4 to reduce front-end costs of selling agricultural lands, it 5 often thwarts the long-term viability of these "units", as 6 master planning is absent, particularly with respect to 7 supporting county infrastructure; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, condominium property regime laws do not require county approval of the condominium property regime, which 11 inhibits a county's ability to plan, regulate, and enforce its 12 agricultural plans, goals, and infrastructure services; and 13 14 WHEREAS, section 205-4.5(f), Hawaii Revised Statutes, 15 specifically allows agricultural land developers to bypass 16 county subdivision requirements, which promotes the condominium 17 property regime process over the county subdivision process; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, certain farms are building residential structures without county permitting when they are only allowed to build 21 structures without permitting or to code if they are 22 agricultural buildings and structures that are exempted by 23 24 section 46-88, Hawaii Revised Statutes; now, therefore, 25 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 26 27 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the House of Representatives concurring, that each county council is 28

urged to adopt supplemental rules pursuant to section 514B-6, 1 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to ensure the conformance of 2 condominium property regimes to the purposes and provisions of 3 county zoning and development ordinances and chapter 205, Hawaii 4 5 Revised Statutes, including section 205-4.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, where applicable; and 6 7 8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City and County of Honolulu is requested to regulate and enforce land use ordinances in the 9 Kunia area; and 10 11 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City and County of Honolulu 13 is requested to create a process to demolish buildings and structures in the Kunia area if they are deemed to be illegal; 14 15 and 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City 18 and County of Honolulu, Director of the Department of Planning 19 and Permitting of the City and County of Honolulu, and Chair of 20 each county council. 21 22 23 OFFERED BY: THINKING 24
