SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A STATEWIDE FIREFIGHTING HELICOPTER PROGRAM.

1	WHEREAS, due to its geographical isolation, Hawaii faces
2	major barriers to effective wildfire response; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, while other states may request out-of-state
5	firefighting agencies under mutual aid agreements to assist in
6	coordinated firefighting efforts due to closer proximity and
7	connected land mass, Hawaii's geographical isolation and unique
8	topography make it increasingly difficult to request similar
9	assistance, only compounding the challenges that local
10	firefighters face in response to a wildfire; and
11	
12	WHEREAS, the threat of wildfires has increased in recent
13	decades due to climate change, adverse weather events, and drier
14	environmental conditions necessitating the State to adapt its
15	firefighting methodology; and
16	
17	WHEREAS, the adoption of a unified, state-driven approach
18	to firefighting would enhance fire safety throughout the State;
19	and
20	
21	WHEREAS, a statewide firefighting helicopter program is
22	imperative for the State to fortify resilience against wildfires
23	and enhance emergency management and response capabilities; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, the individual counties currently operate
26	firefighting helicopters and other resources, that are difficult
27	to deploy outside of a county during times of mass emergencies;
28	and

30	WHEREAS, a helicopter's ability to rapidly intervene in
31	remote and inaccessible areas dramatically increases
32	firefighting capabilities, and if equipped with state of the art
33	technology can deliver targeted water drops, fire retardant, and

other fire suppression agents with precision to maximize the 1 2 efficiency of suppression efforts; now, therefore, 3 4 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the 5 House of Representatives concurring, that a statewide 6 7 firefighting helicopter program is requested to be established; 8 and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature is urged to appropriate the necessary funds to create a dedicated statewide 11 firefighting helicopter program to fortify Hawaii's resilience 12 13 against wildfires, enhance emergency response capabilities, protect the State's natural resources, and ensure the safety of 14 the State's residents and visitors; and 15 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the statewide firefighting helicopter program is requested to retrofit, maintain, staff, 18 operate, and support firefighting helicopters or contract for 19 the provision of these services and enter into agreements with 20 state and county fire departments and emergency management 21 agencies to establish policies and procedures for the deployment 22 of firefighting helicopters; and 23 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Speaker of 26 27 the House of Representatives; President of the Senate, Administrator for the Hawaii Emergency Management Agency, and 28 29 Chair of the State Fire Council. 30 31 32 OFFERED BY:
