
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES AND
DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO WORK WITH THE
CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO ESTABLISH COMMUNITY GARDENS
ON UNDERUTILIZED PUBLIC LAND.

1 WHEREAS, the State has committed to doubling local food
2 production by 2030; and

4 WHEREAS, the State needs to utilize as many means as it can
5 to realize this vision; and

7 WHEREAS, one such avenue is the use of community gardens,
8 which can strengthen community ties and produce substantial
9 amounts of healthy, local produce; and

11 WHEREAS, there are currently underutilized parcels of
12 public land that may be suitable for food production; and

14 WHEREAS, it is worthwhile to convert underutilized public
15 land into community gardens to promote local food production and
16 sustainability; now, therefore,

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second
19 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the
20 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of
21 Accounting and General Services and Department of Land and
22 Natural Resources is requested to work with the City and County
23 of Honolulu to establish community gardens on underutilized
24 public land; and

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
27 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Comptroller,
28 Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources, and
29 Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu.
