SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY TO ASSESS REASONABLE ACCOMMODATIONS FOR BEACH ACCESS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.

WHEREAS, the State is known worldwide for its beaches and 1 is committed to offering beach access to all visitors; and 2 3 WHEREAS, beach access for persons with disabilities, 4 including veterans, is extremely limited, especially for those 5 6 in wheelchairs; and 7 8 WHEREAS, although there is beach wheelchair access at 9 certain beaches in the State, they are not available at most; now, therefore, 10 11 12 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the 13 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of Land 14 and Natural Resources is requested to conduct a feasibility 15 study to assess the provision and maintenance of reasonable 16 accommodations for persons with disabilities to access the 17 18 shoreline of any beach that has a public restroom within an ocean recreation management area; and 19 20 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study is requested to consider factors, including but not limited to: 22 23 (1)24 The topography and physical characteristics of each beach transit corridor; 25 26 27 (2) The county that maintains each beach transit corridor; 28 29 (3) Reasonable accommodations that comply with 28 C.F.R. parts 35 and 36 and chapter 489, Hawaii Revised 30 31 Statutes; and
