## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY TO EXPEDITE THE PLACEMENT OF MAUI WILDFIRE SURVIVORS INTO THE FEDERAL DIRECT LEASE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, in August 2023, the Maui wildfires destroyed or 1 damaged approximately two thousand two hundred structures, 2 leaving thousands of residents displaced and without shelter; 3 4 and 5 WHEREAS, in the immediate aftermath of the tragedy, the 6 7 Federal Emergency Management Agency, State, and American Red Cross worked with the hotel industry to house survivors in the 8 9 non-congregate shelter program; and 10 WHEREAS, as of March 2024, hundreds of survivors and 11 12 families are still without long-term housing; and 13 WHEREAS, one option for long-term housing is the Federal 14 Emergency Management Agency's Direct Lease Program, wherein the 15 agency leases existing, ready-to-occupy residential properties 16 for use as temporary housing for families displaced by the 17 wildfires: and 18 19 WHEREAS, according to information presented at a Hawaii 20 State Senate Ways and Means Committee briefing, there are 21 currently one thousand three hundred units in the Direct Lease 22 Program many of which have yet to be filled; and 23 24 WHEREAS, many survivors have attested that the process of 25 26 obtaining housing through the Direct Lease Program is long and difficult, particularly the credit and background check; and 27 28 29 WHEREAS, it is a moral and financial priority for the State 30 to move as many survivors as possible into long-term housing programs; now, therefore, 31
