
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY TO INSTALL A
NEW EMERGENCY SIREN NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF AUMAKUA STREET
AND AUHUHU STREET IN UPPER PACIFIC PALISADES.

1 WHEREAS, emergency preparedness is of paramount importance
2 to the State; and

3
4 WHEREAS, residents living in the Pacific Palisades area
5 assert that they are unable to hear the emergency siren located
6 at Pearl City High School; and

8 WHEREAS, the emergency siren at Palisades Elementary School
9 has been inoperable for several years; and

11 WHEREAS, the lack of audible, functioning sirens may create
12 a public safety concern in the event of a critical public
13 emergency; and

15 WHEREAS, a new emergency siren is needed in the upper
16 Pacific Palisades area to keep residents alerted to all civil
17 defense emergencies in a timely manner to take any necessary
18 safety measures; now, therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second
21 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the
22 House of Representatives concurring, that the Hawaii Emergency
23 Management Agency is requested to make the installation of a new
24 emergency siren near the intersection of Aumakua Street and
25 Auhuhu Street in upper Pacific Palisades a top priority; and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
28 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Adjutant General of
29 the Department of Defense and Administrator of the Hawaii
30 Emergency Management Agency.
