SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII CLIMATE CHANGE MITIGATION AND ADAPTION COMMISSION TO DEVELOP VEHICLE MILES TRAVELED REDUCTION STRATEGIES AND MAKE RELATED RECOMMENDATIONS.

WHEREAS, decreasing transportation-related emissions is 1 essential to achieving the State's greenhouse gas reduction 2 goals; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Climate Change Mitigation and Adaption 5 Commission found that vehicle miles traveled is an important 6 measurement to track the State's efforts on greenhouse gas 7 reduction; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, current strategies to mitigate vehicle miles traveled in the State are ineffective; and 11 12 WHEREAS, vehicle miles traveled have increased almost forty 13 percent over the last twenty-five years and, without 14 15 intervention, are projected to continue to increase; now, therefore, 16 17 18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, 19 that the Hawaii Climate Change Mitigation and Adaption 20 21 Commission is requested to: 22 (1) Develop vehicle miles traveled strategies; 23 24 (2) Recommend a statewide vehicle miles traveled reduction 25 target; 26 27 (3) Recommend benchmarks for, and evaluate progress 28 toward, the vehicle miles traveled reduction target; 29 30 and 31

Identify state and county agencies to collaborate and 1 (4) coordinate on the implementation of vehicle miles 2 traveled reduction policies, strategies, and programs; 3 4 and 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Climate Change 6 Mitigation and Adaption Commission is requested to submit a 7 8 report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than forty 9 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2025; and 10 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 12 13 Resolution be transmitted to the Co-Chairpersons of the Hawaii Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation Commission. 14 15 16 17 Clun
