SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES AND BOARD OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO ADOPT CERTAIN PROCEDURES RELATING TO THE DAM AND APPURTENANCE IMPROVEMENT OR REMOVAL GRANT PROGRAM TO ASSIST APPLICANTS IN OBTAINING GRANTS.

1 WHEREAS, Hawaii's dams, reservoirs, and spillways are an 2 integral part of the State's existing infrastructure and benefit 3 the State by providing flood protection, viable water supply 4 resources, hydropower, and irrigation access, yet some of these 5 structures possess features that are considered deficient and 6 not in compliance with current safety standards; and 7

8 WHEREAS, the majority of the dams and reservoirs in the 9 State were constructed approximately one hundred years prior, 10 when booming economic activity in the sugarcane and pineapple 11 industries were a driving force in the construction and 12 maintenance of these structures; and

14 WHEREAS, the sugarcane and pineapple industries have 15 dwindled over the past decades, and now render these structures 16 without a significant economic incentive for investment unless 17 the State intervenes to ensure that further dilapidation and 18 deterioration do not occur; and

20 WHEREAS, ensuring the safety of Hawaii's dams is one of the
21 important functions of the Department of Land and Natural
22 Resources; and

WHEREAS, Act 134, Session Laws of Hawaii 2023, codified as 179D-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, established a Dam and Appurtenance Improvement or Removal Grant Program to be developed and administered by the Department of Land and Natural Resources for the improvement or removal of deficient dams in the State; and

31 WHEREAS, the Dam and Appurtenance Improvement or Removal32 Grant Program provides funding to owners of private dams for



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plans, design, construction, and equipment to improve or remove 1 2 deficient dams and appurtenances, as determined by the Department of Land and Natural Resources; and 3 4 WHEREAS, section 179D-31(d), Hawaii Revised Statutes, 5 6 allows the Department of Land and Natural Resources to award 7 grants from the Dam and Appurtenance Improvement or Removal Grant Program based on criteria developed by the Department and 8 the Board of Land and Natural Resources, and therefore, the 9 10 applications to receive grants are subject to the discretion of and uneven application of criteria by the Department and the 11 Board; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the stringent regulatory framework and muddled 14 15 processes to improve and maintain dams, reservoirs, and spillways in the State often disincentivize investment, thereby 16 17 rendering these structures dilapidated, abandoned, and 18 vulnerable to natural disasters; and 19 20 WHEREAS, accessing existing funding mechanisms to improve 21 and maintain these structures also prove challenging for dam and 22 reservoir owners throughout the State; now, therefore, 23 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 25 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, 26 that the Department of Land and Natural Resources and Board of 27 Land and Natural Resources are urged to adopt certain procedures 28 relating to the Dam and Appurtenance Improvement or Removal 29 Grant Program to assist applicants in obtaining grants; and 30 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and 32 Natural Resources is urged to make publicly available the 33 criteria it develops for the award of grants from the Dam and 34 Appurtenance Improvement or Removal Grant Program; and 35 36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, when prescribing other requirements or conditions for compliance by an applicant of the 37 Dam and Appurtenance Improvement or Removal Grant Program 38 pursuant to section 179D-91(d)(10), Hawaii Revised Statutes, the 39 Department of Land and Natural Resources and Board of Land and 40 Natural Resources are urged to prescribe the requirements and 41

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conditions in a manner that is consistent with the principles of 1 2 fairness and equal treatment; and 3 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the requirements and conditions prescribed by the Department of Land and Natural Resources or 5 6 Board of Land and Natural Resources pursuant to section 179D-7 91(d)(10), Hawaii Revised Statutes, are urged to be: 8 9 Based on reasonable and justifiable grounds and (1) 10 relevant to the purpose for which the grant is awarded; 11 12 (2) Communicated to the applicant in a clear, transparent, 13 and reasonable manner; and 14 15 Readily available to the applicant in writing, with 16 (3) one copy submitted to the applicant and another made 17 18 publicly available; and 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and Natural Resources and Board of Land and Natural Resources are 21 urged to allow applicants of the Dam and Appurtenance 22 23 Improvement or Removal Grant Program to: 24 Seek clarification of the additional requirements or 25 (1)conditions prescribed; and 26 27 (2) Appeal the determination of their applications in 28 29 accordance with section 179D-7, Hawaii Revised 30 Statutes; and 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 32 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of 33 34 Land and Natural Resources.

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
