Your Committee on Higher Education & Technology, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 203 entitled:

The purpose of this measure establish a working group to evaluate the effectiveness of the University of Hawaii Community Colleges Summer Tuition Pilot Program.

Your Committee finds that the financial burden on students attending summer classes has been a longstanding concern, often hindering their ability to pursue additional coursework or expedite their degree completion and it is in the legislatures best interest to look at diverse ways to support our community college students.
