RELATING TO PESTICIDES. HB 2337, HD1 AEN, JDC Replaces representatives from the sugar and pineapple (HSCR862-24) industries with representatives of the coffee and diversified agriculture industries on the Advisory Committee on Pesticides. Status & Testimony Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)
