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<u>SB 1392</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO PERIODIC REVIEWS OF DETAINEES IN COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL CENTERS. Repeals section 353-6.2, Hawaii Revised Statues, enacted as part of Act 179, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, to delete the requirement for the Department of Public Safety to reassess pretrial detainees on a regular basis for reconsideration of pretrial release.	PSM, JDC
<u>SB 2543</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO SEARCH AND RESCUE. Requires government entities to seek reimbursement for search and rescue expenses from persons who require rescue after ignoring warning signs, leaving a hiking trail to enter a prohibited area, or hiking on a trail closed to the public.	PSM, JDC/WAM
SB 2693 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO STATES OF EMERGENCY. Establishes the offense of charitable fraud during a state of emergency. Provides that a person commits charitable fraud during a state of emergency if that person, during a state of emergency proclaimed by the Governor, performs certain deceptive acts or practices in connection with the solicitation of a contribution to assist persons affected by a disaster or emergency.	PSM, JDC
<u>SB 2909</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT. Requires the Hawaii Emergency Management Agency to lead the State's emergency management activities in a federally declared disaster.	PSM, JDC

<u>SB 2910</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT. Appropriates funds to the Department of Law Enforcement for an additional fifteen full-time equivalent (15.0 FTE) sheriff positions for transitional law enforcement officer activities in Lahaina. Declares that the general fund expenditure ceiling is exceeded. Makes an appropriation.	PSM, WAM
<u>SB 3009</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT. Specifies the responsibilities of the Department of Law Enforcement's Sheriff Division regarding judicial and legislative security. Requires the Sheriff Division to pursue, obtain, and maintain accreditation from the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc.	PSM, WAM/JDC
