I am in strong support of HCR21\_HR12 which urges the City and County of Honolulu to work with the Department of Transportation on the Department of Transportation services to plan and implement options for alternative ingress and egress in Mililani Mauka.

We urgently need an emergency access road for safe egress in the event of a disaster. Currently, there is only one way in and one way out on Meheula Parkway. The community of the village in Waikoloa (on Hawaii island) has an emergency access road that is only used during an emergency. 2 years ago they had a brush fire that threatened the village and that access road was used to allow residents to evacuate. Otherwise, they only have one way in and one way out. I recommend that you study that community's emergency egress plan.

In 2021, Mililani Mauka had a recorded population of 21,700 people and I suspect it is a greater number in 2024. We also have 2 elementary schools, 1 middle school, 2 preschools, and Olaloa Retirement Community.

My husband and I have been residents of Mililani for 36 years and we currently reside in Mililani Mauka. My husband is a retired Honolulu Fire Department Captain and often comments about the need for safe egress out of Mauka in the event of a disaster.
