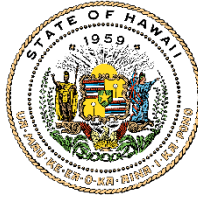

This report is submitted in accordance with Section 134-87 (b)(3), Hawaii Revised Statutes, regarding the maintenance of records and instance of usage of electric guns. This report covers the period from July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024.

Act 148, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, authorized the Department of Land and Natural Resources' Division of Conservation and Resources Enforcement (DOCARE) to equip its officers with electric guns while continuing efforts toward accreditation by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies by June 30, 2018.

During the reporting period, DOCARE reports three (3) instances of the usage of Taser Conductive Energy Weapons (CEW or as referred to in the title of this report as "Electric Guns"). Two instances occurred on Maui, at Maalaea Small Boat Harbor and Kahului Boat Ramp. A third instance occurred on Kauai, in the Poipu area. During these instances, the Taser CEW was deployed to control subjects who were resisting officer control and arrest. In all cases, the subjects were subsequently arrested for various offenses including, but not limited to Resisting Arrest and Disorderly Conduct. Importantly, there were no injuries reported as a result of the electric gun deployment.

Lastly, all Conservation and Resources Enforcement Officers (CREOs) have been trained and are fielding the Axon TASER X26P or Taser 7 CEW. DOCARE continues to provide appropriate in-service recertification training of all CREOs in accordance with the standing policy.
