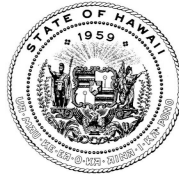

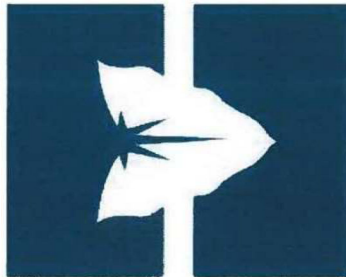

Department of Hawaiian Home Lands

In 2022, the Hawaii'i State Legislature appropriated \$600 million through Act 279 to the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands. The purpose of this funding is to reduce the Hawaiian Homes waitlist. To this end, the Department has been actively pursuing new lot development projects as well as awarding all available lots to beneficiaries on the waitlist.

Section 5 of the Act requires the Department to submit an annual report to the legislature on the first day of each regular session that includes:

1. An accounting of the expenditures for the purposes of this Act in the previous fiscal year; and
2. The number of applicants on the waiting list assisted.

Below please find a report of expenditures and encumbrances for fiscal year 2024 (ending June 30, 2024) as well as the projected number of applicants who will benefit from these development projects.
