Pursuant to Section 52D-3.5 of Hawaii Revised Statutes relating to Uniform Information Practices, during 2024, the Maui Police Department did not sustain any incidents of:

- Mistreatment of a prisoner/arrested person;
- Malicious use of physical force;
- Use and/or possession of drugs and/or narcotics; or
- Cowardice.

Attached is a summary of all sustained violations of department policies and procedures which resulted in suspensions and/or dismissals of police officers during the 2024 calendar year. The following comments are relative to this report:

- While not specified, discipline imposed may be progressive, whereby the prior disciplinary history of an employee is considered.
- The discipline imposed may be appealed and subsequently amended as a result of the SHOPO Collective Bargaining Agreement grievance process.
