A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII NATIONAL GUARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that section 121-12(a),		
2	Hawaii Revised Statutes, currently mandates that the Hawaii army		
3	national guard and air national guard each be headed by an		
4	assistant adjutant general, with the rank capped at brigadier		
5	general. While most states' national guard components are		
6	federally authorized to be headed by officers with a maximum		
7	rank of brigadier general, the Department of the Air Force has		
8	authorized the Hawaii air national guard to be led by an officer		
9	with the rank of major general, reflecting the organization's		
10	size and complexity. Additionally, the chief of staff position		
11	for the Hawaii air national guard is federally authorized at the		
12	grade of major general.		
13	Accordingly, the purposes of this Act are to:		
14	(1) Allow the head of the Hawaii air national guard to		
15	hold the rank authorized by the Department of the Air		
16	Force, which is currently major general;		

1	(2)	Provide the adjutant general with the flexibility to
2		assign either the chief of staff or the assistant
3		adjutant general to lead the Hawaii air national
4		guard; and
5	(3)	Authorize the pay and allowances for the chief of
6		staff of the Hawaii air national guard to be
7		determined according to the pay tables of the regular
8		air force of the United States.
9	SECT	ION 2. Section 121-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended b	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
11	"(a)	The headquarters staff of the national guard shall be
12	composed	of the army national guard component, which shall
13	include a	selective service section, and the air national guard
14	component	. The headquarters shall be staffed by [such] the
15	officers,	warrant officers, and enlisted personnel, in the
16	grades an	d branches of service as may be authorized by the
17	secretari	es of the army and the air force. The army division
18	[and the	air division] shall [cach] be headed by an assistant
19	adjutant	general[, who shall, while holding the office, have a
20	grade no 	higher than brigadier general]. The air division shall
21	be headed	by a chief of staff or an assistant adjutant general,

- 1 as determined by the adjutant general. The assistant adjutants
- 2 general [7] or chief of staff, when in the full-time employment
- 3 of the department of defense, may receive the pay and allowance
- 4 of their grade as fixed by the tables of the regular army or air
- 5 force of the United States."
- 6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
