
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII CONFERENCE CENTER REVOLVING FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to subpart D of part V to be 3 appropriately designated and to read as follows: 4 "§304A- University of Hawaii conference center 5 revolving fund. (a) There is established the university of 6 Hawaii conference center revolving fund for conference center 7 programs conducted by the university. The university may 8 establish and collect fees and charges for the costs of 9 providing these services. All fees, charges, and other moneys 10 collected in conjunction with the conference center programs of 11 the university shall be deposited in separate accounts within the revolving fund. The university may establish accounts under 12 13 the university of Hawaii conference center revolving fund to 14 facilitate the administration of this fund among the various 15 campuses and operating units of the university of Hawaii system. 16 The university is authorized to expend funds from the

2	associated with conducting conferences, seminars, and courses								
3	provided by the conference center programs, including but not								
4	limited to expenses for honoraria, hotel and room rentals, food								
5	and refreshment, printing and mailing, airfare and per diem,

7	related services, fees, supplies and materials, without regard								
8	to section 103D-1002 and any competitive bidding requirements								
9	pursuant to state procurement requirements.								
10	(b) The university shall submit a report to the								
11	legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of								
12	each regular session, accounting for all income and expenditures								
13	of each separate account within the revolving fund."								
14	SECTION 2. Section 304A-2272, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is								
15	repealed.								
16	[" §304A-2272Conference-center-revolving-fund; University								
17	of Hawaii at Hilo. (a) There is established the conference								
18	center revolving fund for conference center programs conducted								
19	by the University of Hawaii at Hilo. All fees, charges, and								
20	other moneys collected in conjunction with conference center								
21	programs shall be deposited in the revolving fund. The								

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1	chancellor of the University of Hawaii at Hilo or the
2	chancellor's designee is authorized to expend funds from the
3	revolving fund for all costs associated with conferences,
4	seminars, and courses provided by conference center programs,
5	including but not limited to expenses for honoraria, hotel and
6	room rentals, food and refreshment, printing and mailing,
7	airfare and per diem, lei, rental of audiovisual equipment, and
8	conference supplies and materials, without regard to any
9	competitive bidding requirements pursuant to chapter 103D.
10	-(b)The-chancellor of the-University of Hawaii at Hilo
11	shall submit a report to the legislature no later than twenty
12	days prior to the convening of each regular session that
13	includes an accounting for all income and expenditures of the
14	revolving fund under this section."]
15	SECTION 3. Section 304A-2273, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
16	repealed.
17	[" [\$304A-2273] Community college conference center
18	revolving-fund. (a) There is established the community-college
19	conference center revolving fund for conference center programs
20	conducted by the various community colleges. All fees, charges,
21	and other moneys collected in conjunction with the conference


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1	center program of each community college shall be deposited in							
2	separate accounts within the revolving fund. The chancellor of							
3	each community college or a designee is authorized to expend							
4	funds from the appropriate account in the revolving fund for all							
5	costs associated with conducting conferences, seminars, and							
6	courses by the conference center program, including but not							
7	limited to expenses for honoraria, hotel and room rentals, food							
8	and-refreshment, printing and mailing, airfare and per diem,							
9	leis, rental of audiovisual equipment, and conference supplies							
10	and materials, without regard to section 103D-1002 and any							
11	competitive bidding requirements pursuant to state procurement							
12	requirements.							
13	(b) The chancellors of the community colleges shall							
14	prepare an annual report to the legislature accounting for all							
15	income-and expenditures of each separate account within the							
16	revolving_fund. "]							
17	SECTION 4. On July 1, 2025, all unencumbered funds in the							
18	conference center revolving fund and in the community college							
19	conference center revolving fund shall lapse to the credit of							
20	the university of Hawaii conference center revolving fund							
21	established pursuant to section 1 of this Act.							

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
