# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LICENSE PLATES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "\$286- License plate flipping devices; prohibited. (a)
- 5 No person shall operate a motor vehicle with, possess, purchase,
- 6 install, sell, offer for sale, or otherwise distribute a license
- 7 plate flipping device. This section shall apply to any motor
- 8 vehicle operated on public roadways in the State, regardless of
- 9 the jurisdiction of registration. Each act described in this
- 10 subsection shall constitute a separate and distinct violation,
- 11 regardless of whether multiple acts occur simultaneously or are
- 12 committed in connection with other violations.
- 13 (b) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter,
- 14 any person who violates this section shall be fined no less than
- 15 \$750 but no more than \$1,000 for each separate violation. Each
- 16 instance of a violation shall constitute a separate offense.

1	<u>(c)</u>	For the purposes of this section, "license plate
2	flipping	device" means a manual, electric, or mechanical device
3	designed	or adapted to be installed on a motor vehicle that:
4	(1)	Switches between two or more license plates for the
5		purpose of allowing a motor vehicle operator to change
6		the license plate displayed on the vehicle; or
7	(2)	Hides a license plate from view by flipping the
8		license plate so that the plate number is not
9		visible."
10	§286- Obstruction of a license plate; prohibited. The	
11	use of any cover or shield installed over a vehicle's license	
12	plate, regardless of transparency or intent, shall be	
13	prohibited. Any person who violates this section shall be fined	
14	no less than \$500 and no more than \$1,000 for each offense.	
15	Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense. For	
16	the purposes of this section, "cover" or "shield" means any	
17	device, material, or film-whether clear, tinted, mirrored,	
18	reflective, or otherwise that is installed over or affixed to a	
19	license plate, and is intended to alter or interfere with the	
20	visibility, legibility, or identification of the license plate	
21	by law enforcement or traffic enforcement systems."

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
