A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SEA SALT PRODUCTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the popularity of
- 2 Hawaii-made sea salt products is on the rise. Sea salt products
- 3 colored with Hawaiian charcoal, volcanic clay, and other natural
- 4 ingredients help to promote the State's businesses.
- 5 The legislature further finds that incorporating the United
- 6 States Food and Drug Administration's industry guidance on the
- 7 use of color additives in sea salt products should be a state
- 8 priority. The guidance indicates that sea salt manufacturers
- 9 who intend to use color additives that are not currently
- 10 approved for food use should first obtain approval through the
- 11 United States Food and Drug Administration's color additive
- 12 petition process.
- 13 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to ensure the
- 14 continued viability of the State's sea salt manufacturing
- 15 industry by appropriating funds to provide education and support
- 16 to local businesses regarding the United States Food and Drug
- 17 Administration's guidance on colored sea salt.

- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$300,000 or so much
