### Aloha President Kouchi and Speaker Nakamura:

The United Public Workers and the employer have reached a tentative agreement concerning collective bargaining for Units 1 (Blue Collar Employees) and 10 (Institutional, Health, and Correctional Workers). Notice of ratification of the agreement was received on April 22, 2025. In accordance with Section 89-11, HRS, cost items must be submitted to the Legislature for appropriation. The following is a summary of the included and excluded requirements of the settlement for the current fiscal biennium which are being transmitted to the Legislature for appropriation:

### Report Title:

Public Employment Cost Items; BU-1 and BU-10; Appropriations; Expenditure Ceiling

### Description:

Provides appropriations for collective bargaining cost items for the members of Units (1) and (10) and their excluded counterparts, including the cost of salary adjustments negotiated between the State and the bargaining unit representative for fiscal biennium 2025-2027. Declares the expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2025-2026 is exceeded. Effective 7/1/2025. (CD1)
