The Hawai'i Government Employees Association and the employer have reached a tentative agreement concerning collective bargaining for Unit 2 (Blue Collar Supervisors). Notice of ratification of the agreement was received on April 24, 2025. In accordance with Section 89-11, HRS, cost items must be submitted to the Legislature for appropriation.
