#### Aloha President Kouchi and Speaker Nakamura:

The Hawai'i Government Employees Association and the employer have reached a tentative agreement concerning collective bargaining for Unit 3 (Nonsupervisory employees in white collar positions). Notice of ratification of the agreement was received on April 24, 2025. In accordance with Section 89-11, HRS, cost items must be submitted to the Legislature for appropriation.
