Aloha President Kouchi and Speaker Nakamura:

The Hawai'i Government Employees Association and the employer have reached a tentative agreement concerning collective bargaining for Unit 8 (Administrative, Professional, and Technical Employees of the University of Hawai'i). Notice of ratification of the agreement was received on April 24, 2025. In accordance with Section 89-11, HRS, cost items must be submitted to the Legislature for appropriation. The following is a summary of the included and excluded requirements of the settlement for the current fiscal biennium which are being transmitted to the Legislature for appropriation:
