# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 291C-107, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) The department of transportation or a county shall
4	consider the following factors when setting a maximum speed
5	limit pursuant to section 291C-102:

7	maximum speed limit is being set[; provided that the

9	the current speed distribution of free-flowing

12	of transportation or any county reduces a maximum
13	speed limit within [one]:
14	(A) One mile of a school; and
15	(B) Ten miles per hour of the current speed limit for
16	that road;

. 2		commercial areas or schools immediately adjacent to
3		the roadway, the department of transportation or a
4		county shall, to the extent practicable, consider
5		guidance provided by the National Association of City
6		Transportation Officials; provided that nothing in
7	•	this paragraph shall be construed to supersede any
8		applicable federal standards or requirements; and
9	[ <del>(2)</del> ]	(3) Any other factors prescribed by the Federal
10		Highway Administration's Manual on Uniform Traffic
11		Control Devices, as amended."

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### Report Title:

DOT; Speed Limits; Factors to Consider; Reduction

#### Description:

Specifies that an engineering study is not required to be considered when reducing the maximum speed limit within ten miles per hour of the current speed limit for that road. Requires the Department of Transportation or a county, to the extent practicable, to consider National Association of City Transportation Officials guidance when setting a maximum speed limit for sections of highways with residential or commercial areas or schools immediately on a highway.
