RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL WORKFORCE HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

14	(h)	The working group shall submit an interim report of	
15	its progress, including any proposed legislation, to the		
16	legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of		
17	the regular session of 2027, and submit a final report of its		
18	findings and recommendations, including any proposed		
19	legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior		
20	to the convening of the regular session of 2028.		
21	(i)	The working group shall be dissolved on June 30, 2028.	

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1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$800,000 or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the 4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 5 2026-2027 for the agricultural workforce housing working group 6 established in section I of this Act to gather the necessary 7 data and prepare the required reports, including any 8 consultation fees and related expenses. 9 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 10 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
