### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TEACHER EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that requiring the board
- 2 of regents to grant a tuition waiver to a resident student
- 3 pursuing a degree in education for the semester or term that the
- 4 student enrolls in a state-approved teacher education program is
- 5 a matter of statewide concern pursuant to article X, section 6,
- 6 of the Hawaii State Constitution.
- 7 SECTION 2. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 8 amended by adding a new section to subpart B of part IV to be
- 9 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- 10 "§304A- Tuition waiver; student teaching hours; resident
- 11 students. (a) The board of regents shall grant a waiver on all
- 12 tuition and mandatory fees for a resident student enrolled in
- 13 the college of education at the university of Hawaii at Manoa
- 14 for the semester or term that the resident student chooses to
- 15 complete the student teaching requirement necessary to earn a
- 16 degree in education; provided that the student is:
