
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LAND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State's purchase
2 of the real property located at 64-486 Kamehameha highway, also
3 known as "weed circle", on the north shore of Oahu, together
4 with collaboration with the city and county of Honolulu in
5 implementing its North Shore Sustainable Communities Plan, are
6 important to realizing sustainable development for communities
7 in the area.

8 The legislature further finds that providing a "park and
9 ride" shuttle service along the north shore of Oahu would reduce
10 traffic congestion and improve the quality of life for area
11 residents. The legislature also finds that the purchase of this
12 real property is essential because the land is intended to serve
13 as the primary parking hub where residents and visitors would be
14 able to park and access the shuttle.

15 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
16 for the purchase of the real property located at 64-486
17 Kamehameha highway on the north shore of Oahu.

1 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2025-2026 to
5 purchase the real property located at 64-486 Kamehameha highway
6 (TMK: 1-6-4-001-015) on the north shore of Oahu.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
8 transportation for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
