A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 353-16.2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) The director may effect the transfer of a committed 4 felon to any correctional institution located in another state 5 regardless of whether the state is a member of the Western 6 Interstate Corrections Compact; provided that the institution is 7 in compliance with appropriate health, safety, and sanitation codes of the state, provides a level of program activity for the 8 9 inmate that is suitable, and is operated by that state, by any 10 of its political subdivisions, or by a private institution; and 11 provided further that the transfer is either: 12 (1) In the interest of the security $[\tau]$ or management of

13 the correctional institution where the inmate is 14 presently placed, or the reduction of prison 15 overcrowding; or

16 (2) In the interest of the inmate[-];

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1	provided further that beginning on July 1, 2028, the director					
2	shall reduce the number of committed felons incarcerated in					
3	private, out-of-state correctional institutions by twenty-five					
4	per cent. Beginning on July 1, 2030, the director shall reduce					
5	the number of committed felons incarcerated in private, out-of-					
6	state correctional institutions by fifty per cent.					
7	As used in this section, "private, out-of-state					
8	correctional institution" shall include any correctional					
9	institution outside the State operated under a public-private					
10	partnership."					
11	SECTION 2. The department of corrections and					
12	rehabilitation shall submit a report to the legislature no later					
13	than twenty days prior to convening of the regular sessions of					
14	2026, 2027, 2028, 2029, 2030, and 2031 on its actions and					
15	progress in meeting the reduction in the number of committee					
16	felons incarcerated in private, out-of-state correctional					
17	institutions as required by this Act.					
18	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed					
19	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.					

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1	SECTION 4.	This Act shal	l take effect	on July 1,	3000.
