A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRADE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§201- Hawaii-Ireland trade commission; established;		
5	membership; duties. (a) There is established within the		
6	department, for administrative purposes only, the Hawaii-Ireland		
7	trade commission. The commission shall consist of eleven		
8	members who shall be appointed as follows:		
9	(1) Five members to be appointed by the governor without		
10	regard to section 26-34;		
l1	(2) Three members to be appointed by the speaker of the		
12	house of representatives; and		
13	(3) Three members to be appointed by the president of the		
4	senate.		
5	Each member shall be appointed for a four-year term;		
16	provided that each member shall hold office until reappointed by		
17	the member's respective appointing authority at the end of the		

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1	member's	term or until the member's successor is appointed. Any
2	vacancy s	shall be filled by the respective appointing authority.
3	All	initial appointments shall be made no later than
4	October 1	., 2025.
5	(b)	The members of the commission shall elect a
6	chairpers	on and vice chairperson from among themselves.
7	<u>(c)</u>	Any action taken by the commission shall be approved
8	by a simp	le majority of its members. A majority of the members
9	of the co	mmission shall constitute a quorum to do business.
10	<u>(d)</u>	Each member of the commission shall have:
11	(1)	Knowledge of, or current or past involvement in,
12		organizations that promote Irish affairs; or
13	(2)	An interest in the well-being of trade relations
14		between Hawaii and Ireland.
15	(e)	The commission shall:
16	(1)	Advance bilateral trade and investment between Hawaii
17		and Ireland;
18	(2)	Initiate joint action on policy issues of mutual
19		interest to Hawaii and Ireland;
20	(3)	Promote business and academic exchanges between Hawaii
21		and Ireland;

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1	(4)	Encourage mutual economic support between Hawaii and
2		<pre>Ireland;</pre>
3	(5)	Encourage mutual investment in the infrastructure of
4		Hawaii and Ireland; and
5	(6)	Address any other issues as determined by the
6		commission.
7	(f)	Beginning with the regular session of 2027, no later
8	than twen	ty days before the convening of each regular session,
9	the commi	ssion shall submit to the legislature and governor a
10	report of	its work during the previous year.
11	<u>(g)</u>	The members of the commission shall serve without
12	compensat	ion but shall be reimbursed for necessary expenses,
13	including	travel expenses, reasonably incurred in the
14	performan	ce of their official duties.
15	(h)	The commission may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91
16	to impleme	ent this section.
17	<u>(i)</u>	As used in this section, "commission" means the
18	Hawaii-Ire	eland trade commission."
19	SECT	ION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general

revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$75,000 or so much

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- 1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 for the
- 2 department of business, economic development, and tourism to
- 3 fund out-of-state relations activities.
- 4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 5 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
- 6 this Act.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
