

A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE LEGISLATURE, THE AUDITOR, THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU, THE OMBUDSMAN, AND THE ETHICS COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 2 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
- 3 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
- 4 that the general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year
- 5 2024-2025 has already been exceeded by \$8,551,796, or 1.0 per
- $\mathbf{6}$ cent. The appropriations contained in sections 2, 3, and 13 of
- 7 this Act will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling
- 8 for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further exceeded by \$30,334,159,
- 9 or 1.0 per cent. This declaration takes into account the
- 10 additional general fund appropriations authorized for fiscal
- 11 year 2024-2025 in this Act only. The reasons for exceeding the
- 12 general fund expenditure ceiling are that:
- 13 (1) The appropriations made in this Act are necessary to
- 14 serve the public interest; and
- 15 (2) The appropriations made in this Act meet the needs
- addressed by this Act.



1	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general		
2	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$12,483,412 or so	
3	much ther	eof as may be necessary to the senate for the following	
4	expenses:		
5	(1)	The sum of \$11,145,162 for defraying any and all	
6		session and nonsession expenses of the senate up to	
7		and including June 30, 2026, including the 2025	
8		regular session, thirty-third legislature of the State	
9		of Hawaii, and pre-session expenses and the expenses	
10		of any committee or committees established during the	
11		interim between the 2025 and 2026 regular sessions;	
12	(2)	The sum of \$1,219,000 for defraying the expenses of	
13		the legislative information system for cost items such	
14		as hardware, software, consultants, installation,	
15		materials, supplies, and other related costs	
16		associated with the legislative information system	
17		that have been or will be incurred; and	
18	(3)	The sum of \$119,250 for defraying the cost of the	
19		legislative broadcasting program to pay for the	
20		production and distribution of broadcasts of	
21		legislative proceedings, including but not limited to	

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2	platforms for public access.		
3	The	sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by	
4	the senat	e.	
5	SECT	ION 3. There is appropriated out of the general	
6	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$17,041,749 or so	
7	much ther	eof as may be necessary to the house of representatives	
8	for the f	ollowing expenses:	
9	(1)	The sum of \$15,927,770 for defraying any and all	
10		session and nonsession expenses of the house of	
11		representatives up to and including June 30, 2026,	
12		including the 2025 regular session, thirty-third	
13		legislature of the State of Hawaii, and pre-session	
14		expenses and the expenses of any committee or	
15		committees established during the interim between the	
16		2025 and 2026 regular sessions;	
17	(2)	The sum of \$994,729 for defraying the expenses of the	
18		legislative information system for cost items such as	
19	,	hardware, software, consultants, installation,	
20		materials, supplies, and other related costs

2		that have been or will be incurred; and
3	(3)	The sum of \$119,250 for defraying the cost of the
4		legislative broadcasting program to pay for the
5		production and distribution of broadcasts of
6		legislative proceedings, including but not limited to
7		television broadcast, live streaming, and internet
8		platforms for public access.
9	The	sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
10	the house	of representatives.
11	SECT	ION 4. Payment of expenses of the senate during the
12	interim b	etween the 2025 and 2026 regular sessions shall be made
13	only with the approval of the president of the senate, and	
14	payment o	f expenses of the house of representatives during the
15	interim between the 2025 and 2026 regular sessions shall be made	
16	only with the approval of the speaker of the house of	
17	represent	atives.
18	SECT	ION 5. Before January 21, 2026, the senate and the
19	house of	representatives shall each have their accounts audited,
20	and a ful	l report of the respective audits shall be presented to

1	the senate and house of representatives convening on
2	January 21, 2026.
3	SECTION 6. Unless otherwise prescribed by law, the
4	expenses of any member of the legislature while traveling abroad
5	on official business of the legislature shall be \$145 a day as
6	authorized by the president of the senate and speaker of the
7	house of representatives.
8	SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the general
9	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$6,561,208 or so much
10	thereof as may be necessary to the office of the auditor for the
11	following expenses:
12	(1) The sum of \$3,611,208 for defraying the expenses of
13	the office of the auditor during fiscal year
14	2025-2026; and
15	(2) The sum of \$150,000 during fiscal year 2025-2026 for:
16	(A) Performing special studies;
17	(B) Improving capabilities for planning, programming,
18	and budgeting;
19	(C) Fulfilling other special requests made of the
20	auditor by the legislature or jointly by the

1		president of the senate and the speaker of the		
2	house of representatives;			
3	(D)	Legislative studies and contractual services for		
4		those studies; and		
5	(E)	Such other purposes as may be determined by the		
6		joint action of the president of the senate and		
7		the speaker of the house of representatives.		
8	The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by			
9	the auditor.			
10	SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the general			
11	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,800,000 or so muc			
12	thereof as may be necessary to the office of the auditor during			
13	fiscal year 2025-2026 to be deposited into the audit revolving			
14	fund established pursuant to section 23-3.6, Hawaii Revised			
15	Statutes.			
16	SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the audit			
17	revolving fund the sum of \$6,800,000 or so much thereof as may			
18	be necessary to the office of the auditor during fiscal year			
19	2025-2026 for the office to conduct or complete its audit			
20	functions as provided by law.			
21	The sum a	ppropriated shall be expended by the auditor.		

- 1 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4,585,330 or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary to the legislative reference bureau
- 4 for defraying the expenses of the legislative reference bureau
- 5 during fiscal year 2025-2026, including equipment relating to
- 6 computer systems programming and operations.
- 7 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
- 8 the legislative reference bureau.
- 9 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,669,017 or so much
- 11 thereof as may be necessary to the office of the ombudsman for
- 12 defraying the expenses of the office during fiscal year
- **13** 2025–2026.
- 14 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
- 15 the ombudsman.
- 16 SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,679,759 or so much
- 18 thereof as may be necessary to the office of the state ethics
- 19 commission for defraying the expenses of the office during
- 20 fiscal year 2025-2026.

1 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by

2 the state ethics commission.

3 SECTION 13. There is appropriated out of the general

4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the following sums or so much

5 thereof as may be necessary to be expended for the purpose of

 $oldsymbol{6}$ accrued vacation payments and vacation transfer payments for any

7 employee leaving the employ of the senate, house of

8 representatives, office of the auditor, legislative reference

9 bureau, office of the ombudsman, and state ethics commission:

17 provided that the appropriate expending agency shall first make

18 payments from the vacation payout allocation before expending

19 funds from turnover and vacancy amounts; and provided further

that any unexpended funds shall lapse to the general fund on

21 June 30, 2026.

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- SECTION 14. As of the close of business on June 30, 2026, 1
- 2 the unexpended or unencumbered balance of any appropriation made
- 3 by this Act shall lapse into the general fund.
- 4 SECTION 15. Each section of this Act is declared to be
- 5 severable from the remainder of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 16. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Legislative Agencies; Appropriations; General Fund Expenditure Ceiling Exceeded

Appropriates funds to provide for the expenses of the Legislature, Auditor, Legislative Reference Bureau, Ombudsman, and Ethics Commission. Declares that certain appropriations will further exceed the state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025.
