A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§302A- High school law enforcement career-pipeline
- 5 initiative. (a) There shall be created in the department a
- 6 high school law enforcement curriculum-to-career-pipeline
- 7 initiative.
- 8 (b) The purpose of the high school law enforcement
- 9 curriculum-to-career-pipeline initiative shall be to enable
- 10 students to pursue training and qualified experiences, as
- 11 approved by a school's administration, pertaining to the field
- 12 of law enforcement and accrue credits to complete graduation
- 13 requirements.
- 14 (c) The department shall collaborate and consult with the
- 15 department of law enforcement and the local police departments
- 16 of the respective counties to develop and implement the high
- 17 school law enforcement curriculum-to-career-pipeline initiative.

17		resource officers, if one is assigned to their high
18		school, in tasks relating to implementing school
19		programs, administering informational sessions, and
20		promoting school safety; and

1	<u>(4)</u>	A dual credit program in accordance with section 302A-	
2		401 with the University of Hawaii and the University	
3		of Hawaii Community Colleges for courses in fields	
4		relating to criminal justice, justice administration,	
5		and criminology.	
6	<u>(f)</u>	The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter	
7	91 to eff	ectuate the purposes of this section."	
8	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general		
9	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much	
10	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the		
11	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year		
12	2026-2027 for the purpose of developing and implementing a high		
13	school law enforcement curriculum-to-career pipeline initiative.		
14	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of		
15	education for the purposes of this Act.

17	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
