
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that traffic safety is a
2 significant and growing concern across the State. The
3 legislature further finds that the use of photo red light
4 imaging detector systems has demonstrated success in reducing
5 collisions and that the use of automated speed enforcement
6 systems will have similarly beneficial effects for traffic
7 safety.

8 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to require the
9 department of transportation to expand the use of photo red
10 light imaging detector systems and automated speed enforcement
11 systems to locations on the north shore of Oahu.

12 SECTION 2. (a) Notwithstanding section 291J-3, Hawaii
13 Revised Statutes, the department of transportation shall expand
14 the use of photo red light imaging detector systems, pursuant to
15 chapter 291J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and automated speed
16 enforcement systems, pursuant to chapter 291L, Hawaii Revised
17 Statutes, to locations on the north shore of Oahu.



1 (b) The department of transportation shall select
2 locations on the north shore of Oahu at which to implement
3 subsection (a). In selecting these locations, the department of
4 transportation shall seek input from the judiciary and the
5 surrounding community.

6 (c) The department of transportation shall submit to the
7 legislature a report concerning its progress in implementing
8 subsection (a) no later than twenty days prior to the convening
9 of the regular session of 2026.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000;
11 provided that this Act shall take effect one year after its
12 approval to allow counties sufficient time to educate the public
13 and adjust their systems accordingly.
