# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC SAFETY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Kamehameha highway,  
2 especially along the North Shore of Oahu, has long been  
3 recognized as one of the most dangerous stretches of roadway in  
4 the State. As it cuts through numerous communities, it presents  
5 heightened risks for pedestrians, cyclists, and drivers. For  
6 decades, concerns have been raised regarding the high number of  
7 accidents and fatalities along this corridor, underscoring the  
8 urgent need for additional safety measures.

9       Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the safe  
10 routes to schools advisory committee to develop and prioritize  
11 three safe routes to schools projects at three schools on  
12 Kamehameha highway.

13       SECTION 2. The safe routes to school advisory council  
14 shall work with the appropriate stakeholders to develop and  
15 prioritize no less than three safe routes to school projects  
16 serving schools directly adjacent to Kamehameha highway.

17       SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
