A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Kamehameha highway,
- 2 especially along the North Shore of Oahu, has long been
- 3 recognized as one of the most dangerous stretches of roadway in
- 4 the State. As it cuts through numerous communities, it presents
- 5 heightened risks for pedestrians, cyclists, and drivers. For
- 6 decades, concerns have been raised regarding the high number of
- 7 accidents and fatalities along this corridor, underscoring the
- 8 urgent need for additional safety measures.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the safe
- 10 routes to schools advisory committee to develop and prioritize
- 11 three safe routes to schools projects at three schools on
- 12 Kamehameha highway.
- 13 SECTION 2. The safe routes to school advisory council
- 14 shall work with the appropriate stakeholders to develop and
- 15 prioritize no less than three safe routes to school projects
- 16 serving schools directly adjacent to Kamehameha highway.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
