A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State is
committed to maintaining the stringent environmental standards
that govern the operations of waste-to-energy facilities and
committed to preventing any backsliding on existing emission
limits that may be proposed by the United States Environmental
Protection Agency.

7 Therefore, to protect against any weakening of applicable 8 emission limits by the United States Environmental Protection 9 Agency, the purpose of this Act is to require an owner or 10 operator of a waste-to-energy facility to comply with certain 11 United States Environmental Protection Agency regulations as 12 they existed on December 31, 2024.

13 SECTION 2. An owner or operator of a waste-to-energy 14 facility shall comply with the emission limitations of the 15 following subparts of title 40 Code of Federal Regulations part 16 entitled "Standards of Performance for New Stationary

3	(1)	Subpart A, "General Provisions";
4	(2)	Subpart Cb, "Emissions Guidelines and Compliance Times
5		for Large Municipal Waste Combustors That are
6		Constructed on or Before September 20, 1994";
7	(3)	Subpart Ea, "Standards of Performance for Municipal
8		Waste Combustors for Which Construction Is Commenced
9		After December 20, 1989 and On or Before September 20,
10		1994";
11	(4)	Subpart Eb, "Standards of Performance for Large
12		Municipal Waste Combustors for Which Construction is
13		Commenced After September 20, 1994 or for Which
14		Modification or Reconstruction is Commenced After June
15		19, 1996"; and
16	(5)	Subpart AAAA, "Standards of Performance for Small
17		Municipal Waste Combustion Units for Which
18		Construction is Commenced After August 30, 1999 or for
19		Which Modification or Reconstruction is Commenced
20		After June 6, 2001".

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1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval

2 and shall be repealed on June 30, 2027.
