- 8 2026-2027 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
- 9 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 10 of budget and finance for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
