BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending the definition of "historic property" to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 ""Historic property" means any building, structure, object,
- 5 district, area, or site, including heiau and underwater site,
- 6 which [is over fifty years old.] predates Statehood Day, August
- 7 21, 1959, and, with respect to buildings and structures, is
- 8 registered on the Hawaii register of historic places."
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 10 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 11 begun before its effective date.
- 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
