A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TWO-WHEELED MOTORIZED VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that vehicular safety has 2 significantly improved in recent decades. Seatbelts have become 3 mandatory, drivers cannot exceed a blood alcohol content of 4 0.008 while legally operating a vehicle, car seats and booster 5 seats for children have become mandatory, and cell phone usage 6 while driving has been restricted. These changes have increased 7 safety on our roads and survivability in the case of accidents. 8 While there was resistance to each of these safety measures, 9 they have all become normalized and largely seen as necessary 10 precautions to promote public safety.

11 The legislature further finds that operators and passengers 12 two-wheeled motorized vehicles are particularly susceptible to 13 injuries and fatalities, as they are fully exposed and lack the 14 protections of cars and other vehicles. One of the easiest 15 methods to increase survivability and lower the chances of brain 16 injury during a crash is to wear a helmet. In cases involving 17 crashes, national statistics show that motorcycle helmets are

1 thirty-seven per cent and forty-one per cent effective in preventing deaths of operators and passengers respectively, and 2 3 sixty-seven per cent effective at preventing head injuries. The 4 data clearly shows that wearing a helmet can save lives. 5 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require all 6 operators and passengers of two-wheeled motorized vehicles to 7 wear safety helmets with securely fastened chin straps while 8 operating or riding on two-wheeled motorized vehicles on 9 highways, streets, roadways, or any other public property in the 10 State. SECTION 2. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 12 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 13 and to read as follows: 14 "\$286- Two-wheeled motorized vehicles; helmets. (a) 15 All operators and passengers of two-wheeled motorized vehicles 16 shall wear a safety helmet with a securely fastened chin strap 17 that meets the specifications and requirements established by 18 rules adopted by the director while operating two-wheeled 19 motorized vehicles on highways, streets, roadways, or any other 20 public property in the State.



1 (b) For the purposes of this section, "two-wheeled 2 motorized vehicle" means any motor vehicle, moped, motor scooter, electric bicycle, electric foot scooter, or any other 3 4 vehicle that is at least partially self-propelled, and has two 5 wheels in contact with the ground." 6 SECTION 3. Section 286-81, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 amended to read as follows: 8 "§286-81 Motorcycle, motor scooter, moped, etc.; 9 protective devices. (a) No person shall operate a motorcycle 10 or motor scooter, on any highway in the State unless the person 11 and any passenger the person carries on the motorcycle or motor 12 scooter wears: 13 Safety glasses, goggles, or a face shield, in the case (1)14 of a motorcycle or motor scooter that is not equipped 15 with windscreens or windshields; and 16 (2) Any other protective devices [, other than a safety 17 helmet,] required by law or rules adopted by the 18 director. 19 For the purpose of meeting the requirements of this subsection, 20 a required device shall meet the specifications and requirements established by rules adopted by the director. 21

Notwithstanding subsection (a) and section 291C-195, 1 (b) 2 no person shall operate a moped or motor scooter leased from a 3 rental company on any roadway in the State unless the person 4 wears a safety helmet, which shall be provided by the rental 5 company unless the person provides the person's own safety 6 helmet [; provided that this subsection shall not apply to 7 persons who possess a valid license under this chapter to 8 operate a motorcycle or an equivalent license issued from 9 another state]. To meet the requirements of this subsection, the safety helmet shall meet the specifications and requirements 10 11 established by rules adopted by the director. 12 (C) In addition to the requirements of subsection (b), no

13 person shall lease or rent a motorcycle or motor scooter to 14 another person unless the person furnishes:

15 (1) Safety glasses, goggles, or a face shield, in the case
16 of a motorcycle or motor scooter that is not equipped
17 with windscreens or windshields; and

18 (2) Any other protective devices required by the rules
19 adopted by the director for the use of the person or
20 persons intending to operate or ride as a passenger on
21 the motorcycle or motor scooter; provided that any

person to whom a motorcycle or motor scooter is leased			
or rented may furnish for the person's own use the			
protective devices required by this part.			
For the purposes of meeting the requirements of this subsection,

(d) No person shall sell, offer for sale, or furnish any			
safety helmet, safety glasses, goggles, face shield, windscreen,

[(e) No person less than eighteen years of age shall			
operate or ride as a passenger on a motorcycle or motor scooter			
on any highway in the State unless the person wears a safety			
helmet-securely fastened with a chin-strap.			
(f)] (e) A safety helmet shall not be required for any			
person who operates or rides as a passenger on a motorcycle or			
motor scooter; provided that the motorcycle or motor scooter:			
(1) Has three wheels;			
(2) Is powered by an electric motor;
