

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART 1		
2	SECTION 1. Section 132D-20, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
3	amended to read as follows:		
4	"§132D-20 Enforcement; probable cause for arrest. (a)		
5	This chapter shall be enforced by the department of law		
6	enforcement or each county. The department of law enforcement		
7	and counties, or both, are authorized to enforce and administer		
8	the provisions of this chapter.		
9	(b) Arrests for offenses under this chapter or under a		
10	county fireworks ordinance shall be made in compliance with		
11	chapter 803. The facts and circumstances to establish probable		
12	cause for an arrest may include but are not limited to:		
13	(1) Statements from individuals who witnessed the offense		
14	even if those individuals are not law enforcement		
15	officers; and		
16	(2) Photographs, video recordings, or other recordings		
17	that show the commission of the offense and can be		

1		authenticated by one or more witnesses; provided that
2		a recording made using an unmanned aerial vehicle
3		shall be exempt from the requirement of authentication
. 4		by one or more witnesses.
5	<u>(c)</u>	Video recordings made by a law enforcement agency
6	using, co	ntrolling, or operating an unmanned aerial vehicle
7	shall est	ablish probable cause for an arrest if:
8	(1)	The unmanned aerial vehicle is recording directly
9		above a public park, street, sidewalk, easement, or
10		any public property; and
11	(2)	The act leading to the arrest is committed on a public
12		street, sidewalk, or other public property.
13	<u>(d)</u>	For the purposes of this [subsection:] section:
14	"Oth	er recording" includes any photograph or a video made
15	using an	unmanned aerial vehicle.
16	"Unm	anned aerial vehicle" means any aerial vehicle that is
17	operated	without the possibility of direct human intervention
18	within or	on the aerial vehicle. The term "unmanned aerial
19	vehicle"	does not include a remote-controlled airplane."

1	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general		
2	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,000,000 or so much		
3	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the		
4	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year		
5	2026-2027 for the purchase of unmanned aerial vehicles to		
6	monitor the use of illegal fireworks.		
7	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department		
8	of law enforcement for the purposes of this Act.

Department of Law Enforcement; Fireworks; Unmanned Aerial Vehicles; Video Recordings; Probable Cause; Appropriation

Description:

PART I: Allows video recordings made by law enforcement agencies who are using, controlling, or operating an unmanned aerial vehicles to establish probable cause for an arrest under the Fireworks Control Law if the unmanned aerial vehicle is recording directly above a public park, street, sidewalk, easement, or any public property and the act leading to the arrest is committed on a public street, sidewalk, or other public property. PART II: Appropriates funds to the Department of Law Enforcement for the purchase of unmanned aerial vehicles to monitor the use of illegal fireworks.

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
