

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 378, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated			
3	and to read as follows:			
4	"§378- Paid rest periods. (a) Employers shall allow			
5	each employee a rest period consisting of not less than ten			
6	consecutive minutes for each four hours of work time. Insofar			
7	as practicable, the rest period shall be in the middle of each			
8	work period. Rest periods under this paragraph shall be counted			
9	as time worked, for which there shall be no deduction from			
10	wages.			
11	(b) Any employer that fails to allow an employee a rest			
12	period under subsection (a) shall:			
13	(1) For each workday that the rest period is not provided,			
14	pay that employee for not less than one additional			
15	hour of work at the employee's regular rate of			
16	compensation; and

8	(d) Thi	s section shall not be co	onstrued to prohibit any		
9	employer from providing rest periods that are longer than ten				
10	consecutive minutes or that occur more frequently than each four				
11	hours of work time."				
12	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that				
13	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were				
14	begun before its effective date.				
15	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.				
16	SECTION	4. This Act shall take 6	effect on January 1, 2026.
