### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ANIMAL FUR PRODUCTS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that eliminating the sale
- 2 of new animal fur products in the State will decrease demand for
- 3 cruel products, reduce public health risks, promote community
- 4 awareness of animal welfare, alleviate environmental burdens,
- 5 and enhance the reputation of the State.
- 6 SECTION 2. Chapter 183D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended by adding a new section to part V to be appropriately to
- 8 be appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- 9 "S183D- Fur products; Sale, display, possession,
- 10 distribution, or trade; prohibition. (a) It shall be unlawful
- 11 to sell, offer for sale, possess with intent to sell, display
- 12 for sale, distribute, or otherwise trade a fur product in the
- 13 State. The sale, offer for sale, possession with intent to
- 14 sell, display for sale, distribution for sale, or trade of a fur
- 15 product shall be deemed to occur if:
- 16 (1) The buyer takes physical possession of the fur product
- in the State; or

16	separate offense.		
17	(d)	The department may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91	
18	to further	implement or enforce this section.

"Fur	product" means any article of clothing or covering for
any part	of the body, or any fashion accessory, including but
not limit	ed to handbags, shoes, slippers, hats, earmuffs,
scarves,	shawls, gloves, jewelry, keychains, toys or trinkets,
and home	accessories or decor made in whole or in part with fur.
<u>"</u> Fur	product" does not include:
(1)	An animal skin or any part thereof that is intended to
	be converted into leather, or which through processing
	will have the hair, fleece, or fur fiber completely
•	removed;
(2)	Fur, wool, or other fibers sourced exclusively from
	any member of the family Bovidae, Camelidae, Equidae,
	Suidae, or Cervidae;
(3)	Animal hair, fleece, or fur fibers that are not
	attached to skin, such as fishing lures;
(4)	A raw or green pelt, or a dried, cured, or tanned pelt
	that has not been manufactured into and is not sold as
	an article of clothing, covering for any part of the
	body, or fashion accessory, such as pelts or pieces
	used to create fishing lures or for the repair or
	alteration of used fur products; or
	any part not limit scarves, and home "Fur (1)

1	(5) The pelt or skin of any animal preserved through			
2	taxidermy or for the purposes of taxidermy.			
3	"Taxidermy" means the practice of preparing and preserving			
4 .	the skin of an animal that is deceased and stuffing and mounting			
5	the deceased animal in lifelike form.			
6	"Ultimate consumer" means a person who buys a fur product			
7	for the person's own use, or for the use of another, but not for			
8	resale or trade.			
9	"Used fur product" means a fur product that has been			
10	previously worn or used by an ultimate consumer."			
11	SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that			
12	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were			
13	begun before its effective date.			
14	SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.			
15	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 2025.
