BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:


1 SECTION 1. Section 87A-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) The board shall establish the health benefits plan or
4 plans, which shall be exempt from the minimum group requirements
5 of chapter 431~~[-]~~; provided that the health benefits plan or
6 plans shall meet or exceed the requirements of chapter 393."

7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
