A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that teachers understand
- 2 their students' needs and tailor their classrooms to create an
- 3 engaging and effective learning experience. Nationwide,
- 4 teachers spend an average of \$500 out of pocket on their
- 5 classrooms each year. To alleviate the financial burden on
- 6 teachers, the department of education is committed to providing
- 7 funding for teacher-requested classroom supplies. The
- 8 department of education also intends to engage in public-private
- 9 partnerships focused on leveraging existing financial resources
- 10 from both sectors, to provide teachers and students with
- 11 project-based resources.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 13 department of education for teacher-requested classroom
- 14 supplies.
- 15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$3,000,000 or so much
- 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the



- 1 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 2 2026-2027 for teacher-requested classroom supplies.
- 3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 4 of education for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
