
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AMBULANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is of critical
2 concern for the State to ensure its residents have prompt access
3 to primary health care. The legislature further finds that in
4 the county of Maui, ambulance services are being provided
5 through a private contract with American Medical Response with
6 state funding, and that a total of nine ambulances are based at
7 various state, county, and private facilities throughout the
8 county -- specifically, one unit each in east Maui, Kahului, and
9 Wailuku, and two units each in south Maui, west Maui, and
10 upcountry Maui.

11 The legislature also finds that there has been significant
12 population growth in central Maui, and therefore, residents in
13 the area would greatly benefit from the addition of an advanced
14 life support ambulance. The legislature further finds that an
15 advanced life support ambulance will help reduce death and
16 disability among residents and visitors to central Maui by
17 providing timely responses to 911 calls, which is critical to



1 increasing the likelihood of successful outcomes for injured or
2 sick individuals.

3 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to:

4 (1) Purchase one advanced life support ambulance and
5 related equipment to be based in the central Maui area
6 of the county of Maui and fund pay-related personnel
7 costs for state-certified emergency medical services
8 personnel; and

9 (2) Increase the predictability and stability of available
10 air ambulance services for all islands in the State.

11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
13 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
14 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
15 year 2026-2027 for the purchase of one advanced life support
16 ambulance and related equipment to be based in the central Maui
17 area of the county of Maui, and to fund pay-related personnel
18 costs for one state-certified emergency medical technician and
19 one state-certified paramedic.

20 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
21 of health for the purposes of this Act.



SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2026-2027 to increase the predictability and stability of available air ambulance services for all islands in the State.

The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department of health for the purposes of this Act.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.
